

TERMS FOR REDUCED RATES

In addition to its regular rate, Maregiglio srl offers the following rates:

Resident rate

This rate is applied to all those who prove they are residents of the Municipality of Giglio Island, and holders of a document issued by the Company.

The reduced rate can be requested at the ticket office when the ticket is purchased by showing, for each individual passenger, a valid document showing his/her personal details, verifying their residency.

For motor vehicles accompanying the passenger, the vehicle registration must be shown certifying ownership to a resident of Giglio Island.

The above rate will not be applied to vehicles driven by non-residents.

The resident rate will not be applied to vehicles owned by non-residents even if driven by a resident.

Reduced rate

The reduced rate is applied to those who have a document issued by the company.

The reduced rate can be requested by showing the aforementioned document with a valid identity card at the ticket office for each individual passenger.

If there is a vehicle accompanying the passenger, the vehicle registration must be shown.

If the owner of the vehicle does not have the document issued by the Company, the reduced rate for the vehicle will not be applied.

Commercial rate

The commercial rate applies to those with a VAT number who own motor vehicles used to transport goods.

The commercial rate does not apply on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

Rate for disabled persons

Disabled persons with 100% certified disability who need a companion may request free passage for their companion but not for the accompanying vehicle.

To obtain this reduced rate, they must show documentation attesting to their 100% disability at the ticket office.

Disabled persons with 100% certified disability who do not need a companion but do have an accompanying vehicle can request the reduced rate for themselves and the vehicle if they own it, as proven by the vehicle registration.

To obtain this reduced rate, they must show documentation attesting to their 100% disability at the ticket office.
